The Specialty judge will be **Desmond Murphy** from New York, with Puppy Sweeps judged by club member **Larisa Hotchin**. The Club's Awards Event will be held during the noonhour, and the Terrier Breeders' Specialty will be held the following day.

Show Chair Margaret Jones has provided this information about our judge, Desmond Murphy. He came from a dog family and has been judging since 1976. His first dog was a Lakeland and in his 20's he bred Norwich terriers. His father and two brothers were Professional Handlers. He started Bullyganza and Breeders Showcase at the Santa Barbara Kennel Club.



# In Memoriam – Tim Doxtater

We recently learned that Club Life Member, Tim Doxtater, has passed away on Nov. 19 from cancer. Along with his partner, Don Emslie, who pre-deceased him, they established Annfield Miniature Schnauzers back in the 1980s, and quickly gained a reputation for excellent breeding and superior grooming. Their dogs, always owner handled, consistently placed in the top 5 of their breed year after year. According to the Historic Top Dog Database, for the years 1988-2017, four of the top 12 Min. Schnauzers (in terms of career points) were Annfield dogs, and between them, those four garnered 30 BIS and numerous group placements, among the many other Annfield dogs and Champions they showed. They also were consistent winners of the Club's Top Terrier and Top Puppy of the Year. As they gradually moved towards retirement, Don and Tim became well-regarded judges, and travelled across Canada, the U.S. and internationally to accept judging assignments.

Don & Tim also donated the Annfield Novice Exhibitor Trophy that is awarded annually to any Club Member who has been showing terriers for less than 5 years. On the Club's website in the Archive section for Club Trophies, it is interesting to see the annual list of winners going back to 2000. Their intention was to attract and encourage new exhibitors to the Terrier ring, and in that sense, their award has done just that. And of course, their breeding line continues to influence the breed quite widely.




